Subject: Revised NPIs for High Disease Prevalence Cities

COVID update at PM office dated 2nd August 2021 reference.

1. COVID update encompassing proposed NPIs was presented by NCOC to Honourable Prime Minister of Pakistan on 2nd August 2021. After taking a detailed stock of current COVID situation in different parts of country, Honourable Prime Minister very kindly consented the approval of stringent measures for high disease prevalence cities only (Lahore, Rawalpindi, Faisalabad, Multan, Peshawar, Abbottabad, Muzaffarabad, Mirpur, Gilgit, Skardu and Islamabad). As regards to Karachi and Hyderabad, stringent measures already enforced by Sindh Government.

2. Revised NPIs for high disease prevalence cities are as under:-

Ser	Sector	NPIs	NPIs Effective Duration
a.	Business Timings	Market / business activities will continue till 08:00 pm less essential services (Petrol Pumps, Pharmacies, Medical Facilities, Vaccination Centers, Milk / Dahi Shops and Tandoors).	
b.	Closed Days	There will be 2 x closed days during a week. Choice of closed days will be at the discretion of federating units.	
C.	Dining	Complete ban is imposed on indoor dining; however, outdoor dining will be allowed till 10:00 pm under strict COVID protocols. Takeaways are allowed 24/7.	
d.	Weddings	Indoor weddings will be banned with effect from 8 th August 21. Outdoor weddings will be allowed with maximum 400 x guests under strict COVID protocols. Timings for outdoor weddings will be till 10:00 pm.	
e.	Religious	There will complete closure of shrines.	
f.	Cinemas	There will complete closure of cinemas.	3 rd August to 31 st August 21
g.	Gatherings	Ban is imposed on all types of indoor gatherings including cultural, musical / religious / miscellaneous event; however, outdoor gatherings will be allowed for maximum 400 x individuals under strict COVID protocols.	
h.	Sports	Continuation of ban on contact sports (Karate, Boxing, Martial Arts, Rugby, Water Polo, Kabaddi & Wrestling) will be ensured by federating units.	
i.	Gyms	Continuation of indoor Gyms for vaccinated individuals only.	
j.	Office Routine	Normal office working hours for public / private offices will continue; however, attendance level is reduced from 100% to 50 %.	
k.	Public Transport	Occupancy level of public transport is reduced from 70% to 50%. Ban is imposed on all type of snacks serving to the passengers during journey by the transport services.	
I.	Railways	Rail services will continue to operate with 70% occupancy under strict COVID protocols.	
m.	Recreation	Closure of amusement parks, water sports & swimming pools; however, public parks will remain open under strict COVID protocols.	
n.	Education	Decision will be taken by Federal Education Ministry during IPEMC planned on 4 th August 21.	
0.	Extended	Broader lockdowns with stringent enforcement	
	Lockdowns	protocols based on risk assessment will continue. NCOC will regularly share heat maps with federating units for implementation of targeted SLDs / mSLDs.	

Ser	Sector	NPIs	NPIs Effective Duration
p.	Mask Wearing	Compliance to compulsory mask wearing while incorporating innovative measures for enforcement.	
q.	Tourism	Policy of controlled tourism for vaccinated individuals will continue and will be ensured by federating units.	
r.	Meal / Snacks Serving during Domestic Air Travel	Ban is imposed on serving of meals / snacks during inflight journey for domestic airlines.	
S.	Inbound Passenger policy	Current inbound passenger policy will continue till further orders.	

Above mentioned revised NPIs will remain enforced from 3rd August to 31st August 21 for high 3. disease prevalence cities. In order to afford sufficient cushion time for already booked indoor wedding events, ban on indoor weddings will start with effect from 8th August 21.

Since, Sindh Government has imposed stringent measures in Karachi and Hyderabad till 4. 8th August 21; therefore, above mentioned revised NPIs will be applicable to Karachi and Hyderabad with effect from 9th August 21.

NPIs for Low Disease Prevalence Cities (Cities other than as mentioned vide para 1 ante). 5. Current NPIs already enforced with effect from 1st July 21 will further continue for low disease prevalence cities.

NPIs review will be carried out at NCOC on 25th August 21. 6.

A close monitoring of disease prevalence / critical health care system is being carried out at 7. NCOC on daily basis and necessary decisions will be taken accordingly whenever deemed appropriate to control the disease spread.
