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Subject: NCOC Decisions and NPIs

NCOC session dated 28th June 2021 reference.

1. NCOC session chaired by Mr Asad Umer (Federal Minister for Planning, Development, Reforms and Special Initiatives) was held on 28th June 2021. A detailed review of current disease situation in the country and corresponding NPIs was carried out. Forum agreed on implementation of following NPIs / decisions as per dates mentioned against each.

2. Revised NPIs are as under:-

Ser	Sector	NPIs	With effect from / Remarks
a.	Business Timings	Market / business activities will continue till 10:00 pm. However, essential services i.e Petrol Pumps, Pharmacies / Medical Facilities, Vaccination Center, Milk / Dahi Shops, Tandoors and Takeaways are allowed 24/7.	1 st to 25 th July 2021
b.	Dining	 Indoor & outdoor dining is allowed till 11:59 pm. However, indoor dining at 50% occupancy is allowed for vaccinated individuals only. Restaurants / hotels management will institute mechanism for checking of vaccination certificates of guests and will also ensure vaccination of respective management / staff. Takeaways are allowed 24/7. 	
c.	Marriages	 Outdoor marriages / functions allowed with 400 x guests with strict COVID SOPs. Indoor Marriages allowed only for vaccinated individuals with maximum guest limit of 200 x guests. Wedding halls association / management will institute mechanism for checking of vaccination certificates of guests and will also ensure vaccination of respective management / staff. 	
d.	Religious	Shrines are allowed to re-open at the discretion of federating units / local district administration; while adherence to strict COVID SOPs.	
е.	Cinemas	Cinemas are allowed to re-open with strict COVID protocols for vaccinated individuals only till 01:00 AM . Cinemas management will institute mechanism for checking of vaccination certificates of visitors and will also ensure vaccination of respective management / staff.	

3. NPIs continue to remain enforced:-

Ser	Sector	NPIs	With effect from / Remarks
a.	Extended Lockdowns	Broader lockdowns with stringent enforcement protocols based on risk assessment will continue. NCOC will regularly share heat maps with federating units for implementation of lockdowns.	
b.	Gatherings	Ban on all types of indoor / outdoor gatherings including cultural, musical / religious / miscellaneous events will continue.	Status quo will be maintained
C.	Office Routine	Continuation of normal working hours for public / private offices with 100 % attendance.	
d.	Sports	Continuation of ban on contact sports (Karate, Boxing, Martial Arts, Rugby, Water Polo, Kabaddi & Wrestling), festivals, cultural and other events.	

Ser	Sector	NPIs	With effect from / Remarks
e.	Gyms	 Reopening of indoor Gyms only for vaccinated individuals / members. Mandatory vaccination of Gym staff / management will be sole responsibility of owner. Gyms management will institute mechanism for checking of vaccination certificates of visitors and will also ensure vaccination of respective management / staff. 	
f.	Public	Public transport is allowed to operate with 70%	
	Transport	occupancy with strict COVID SOPs / mandatory wearing of masks.	
g.	Railways	Rail services are allowed to operate with 70% occupancy with strict COVID SOPs / mandatory wearing of masks	Status quo will be maintained
h.	Closed Days	There will be 1 x closed day during a week. Selection of closed day will be at the discretion of federating units.	
i.	Recreation	Amusement parks, water sports & swimming pools to continue activities at 50 % capacity.	
j.	Mask Wearing	Compliance to compulsory mask wearing by all federating units while incorporating innovative measures for enforcement.	
k.	Inbound Passenger policy	Current inbound passenger policy will continue till further orders.	
١.	Tourism	Policy on tourism will be issued separately.	

3. All NPIs mentioned above will remain enforced from 1st to 31st July 2021, review will be carried out at NCOC on 27th July 2021. Any further relaxation in NPIs (as and when decided) will be linked with vaccination.

4. A critical monitoring of disease prevalence / critical health care system is being carried out by NCOC on daily basis and necessary decisions will be taken accordingly whenever deemed appropriate to control the disease spread.
